

A Saint-Bernard for your event

We only participate in events that are generally coordinated to ensure the welfare of our Saint-Bernards. The organiser must be able to apply the rules for dogs at events in their entirety.

The Fondation Barry is committed to providing qualified and highly competent staff to accompany our dogs during your event.

Rules for dogs at events

- A dog should not be in direct contact with the public for more than 30 minutes. It must be given sufficient time to rest.
- If the event lasts longer than 30 minutes, a retreat area of at least 10m² for 1-2 dogs is required. For each additional dog, an additional 5m² is required. The room should be well ventilated and have a temperature between 15 and 25 degrees. The room must be lockable and accessible only to the dog keeper.
- The transport vehicle for the dogs should have a dedicated parking space near the event.
- A green space for the dogs' needs must be accessible near the event.
- Dogs must not be exposed to excessive noise, glare, etc. for prolonged periods.
- If there are large numbers of people, a protected area should be set aside for the dogs so that only certain people have direct contact with them.
- Dogs should not be kept in close proximity to foodstuffs.
- Dogs need fresh water at all times. Access to water must be indicated to the dog keeper at the beginning of the event.
- Obtaining permission for the use of dogs at events is the responsibility of the organiser and the costs involved are to be borne by the organiser. The Fondation Barry submits the application to the competent cantonal veterinary office.
- If certain points are not respected or exceeded, the Fondation Barry will withdraw from the event. In every situation, the welfare of the dogs is of utmost importance.
