Before and during your stay

- ➔ The customer is responsible for the journey to and from the accommodation.
 - **Public transport:** timetable on www.cff.ch → Le Grand-St-Bernard, Hospice
 - Free outdoor **parking** for the duration of your stay
- ➔ **Hospice Museum:** open daily from 10.00 am to 6.00 pm
- ➔ **Private dogs** accepted on request: CHF 10 per dog per night (food not provided). Private dogs are not permitted during the activity (Day 2).

Day 1

- ➔ **Check-in:** from 3.00 pm to 7.00 pm
- ➔ **Dinner** from 6.45 pm to 8.30 pm. The evening menu is included, excluding drinks. It is possible to order à la carte for a supplement.

Day 2

- ➔ **Breakfast** from 7.30 am to 10 am
- ➔ **Activity** with the St. Bernard dogs, in a group (approx. 1 hour): Meet at 9.30 am in front of the entrance to the Hospice Museum. Medium difficulty hike, not suitable for children under 6.
- ➔ **Check-out:** 8.00 am to 11.00 am
